## **Conference Paper Preparation Guidelines (English Submissions)**

- 1. Conference papers should be primarily in English.
- 2. Conference papers will be printed in black and white as complete manuscripts; therefore, please adhere to the following format when preparing your manuscript.
- 3. Paper Size and Pages:

For both practical and academic research, compile your manuscript within 2 sheets of A4-sized paper, following the provided format.

- 4. Font and Margins:
  - (1) Set margins on all sides to 15mm.
  - (2) Use the fonts Times New Roman.
  - (3) Use a font size of 12pt
- 5. Title, Names, etc.:
  - (1) Use the top line or the second line for the title and bold formatting. If there is a subtitle, it should be on a separate line.
  - (2) **Author names should be placed on the 4th and 5th lines**, with affiliations in parentheses. Place a circle mark (0) **before the author's name**.
- 6. Keywords:
  - (1) Include approximately 2 to 5 keywords on the 6th line.
- 7. Main Text:
  - (1) Begin the main text from the **7th line**.
  - (2) Format the text in a vertical and **two-column layout**.
  - (3) Even when using figures, tables, or photos, ensure they are placed within the main text frame. However, only **one figure or table is allowed**.
  - (4) When citing references, you can include up to 3 main ones.
  - (5) For anything beyond the above, please refer to the **APA** 7<sup>th</sup> edition guidelines.
- 8. Structure:

Organize the paper by sections, such as purpose, methodology, results, conclusion, to present the research comprehensively. Keep in mind that there is a page limit, so present essential information clearly and concisely.

9. Submission Format:

Submit two types of files as follows:

- (1) The main manuscript in Word (Windows Microsoft Office) format.
- (2) A review-ready manuscript in PDF format with the author's name and affiliation (4th and 5th lines) removed.

- 10. Attach both types of files and submit them through the JASM's website application form. Submission Deadline: Must be received by Saturday January  $6^{th}$  2024(17.00 JST).
  - **\*\*Manuscripts not following the preparation guidelines will not be accepted. Please thoroughly review the guidelines before submission.**
